



# 2020 Street Rehabilitation Project

## Street Paving (Thursday 9/24 & Friday 9/25), Etc.

### September 23, 2020

#### Street Paving & Parking:

**Thursday, September 24<sup>th</sup>**, the Contractor will be paving the asphalt base lift on **Ruth Street, Ely Street, Ashton Avenue, Liberty Street, Longfellow Street and the intersection at Ironton Street/Ashton Avenue.**

**Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>**, the Contractor will pave **79<sup>th</sup> Way. The map on the reverse side shows the paving limits.** The Contractor will begin at 7:00 a.m. on both Thursday and Friday, weather permitting. Note the final lift of pavement is tentatively scheduled for October 6<sup>th</sup>. An additional notice will be posted as we approach that date.

We ask that you please stay off the new pavement for as long as possible. You will have access to your driveway at the end of the day. This allows for the asphalt to cure and will produce the best final product. Residents within the paving areas may park on the previously paved streets. *Please access East River Road to the north via Ashton Avenue, Ironton Street & Hugo Street during the day. In general, the contractor will be working from the north to south and will pave Ashton Avenue at the end of the day Thursday.*

As a reminder, we ask that no vehicles or property be parked on project area streets during working hours (7am-7pm Mon-Fri). This gives the Contractor room to work and prevents any damage to personal property. In general, the Contractor will accommodate residential and business traffic during paving operations.

#### Asphalt Driveways:

The portions of asphalt driveways removed during construction will be paved during this phase of work. **If your driveway isn't paved Thursday, the Contractor will return Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup> to complete driveways in the project area.** If possible, it is best to keep off the newly paved driveway for three days to allow for curing.

#### Boulevard Restoration & Irrigation Repair:

Moving forward the contractor will begin restoring the boulevard areas disturbed during construction. This work will be completed prior to paving the final lift of pavement. This phase of work involves light grading, irrigation repair, placing topsoil and seeding.

#### Resident Access

The City and Contractor will do everything possible to minimize the inconvenience to residents in the construction areas.

However, please note that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, and mud, and is generally a disruption to the area. Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street.

#### Worksite Safety

Although it is tempting and interesting to watch, it is very important that residents, including children, remain out of the immediate work zone. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction workers, equipment and warning signs.

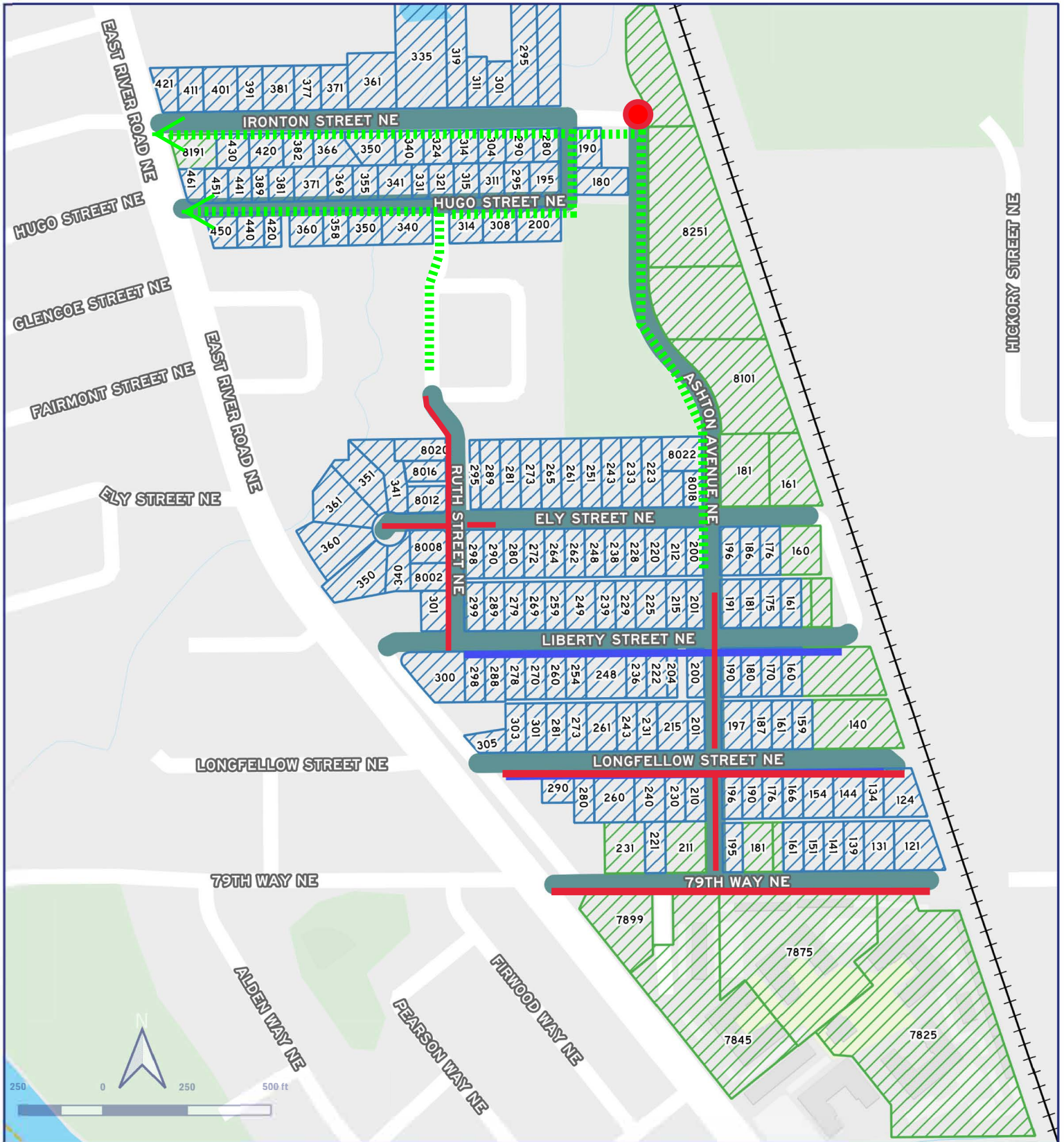
